PREFACE

This Handbook covers details of staff work for commanders and staff officers when planning or conducting operations in a national context.

In retrospect, officers in the RSLAF have been attending courses in different countries and these countries use varying military symbols and abbreviations. Owing to variation in staff skills acquired by officers from different overseas training; unparallel forms of writing in various RSLAF publications have emerged and have been glaringly evident to date in the RSLAF. In recent times, it has also been observed that certain officers have been formulating their own abbreviations thus causing obscurity in the Defence Writing system.

It is but essential to standardize the abbreviations across the force. The Defence Writing Handbook produced by IMATT (Horton Academy), which is the current guide to RSLAF: Defence, Operational and Staff Writing, does not cover all abbreviations. Therefore, cohesive and comprehensive abbreviations have been formulated in this publication with a view to standardizing Defence Staff and Operational writing in the RSLAF.

The material has been culled from the Staff Officers' Handbook (July 2010) and covers abbreviations most currently used in operational environment, operational orders, other documents and forms. They are not definitive and new abbreviations may be added from time to time.

There is always discussion in RSLAF circles as to what acronyms and abbreviations are authoritative. This publication ends this perennial debate. The detailed contents of this Handbook are authoritative. If any reader wishes to add/subtract or raise a new acronym term or abbreviation he/she is invited to write to the Assistant Chief of Defence Staff, Personnel & Training (ACDS Pers &Trg) who will direct, if necessary, the Director Defence Training, Education and Recruitment to present it at the next Defence Policy Committee (DPC) meeting for approval.
